The new Oxford House School website has been launched! You should have received a password and login details to access the parents tab. Once again, thank you to everyone involved.

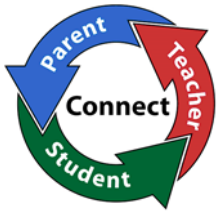


**Thank you to everyone who donated to Children in Need today. The children have had a fun filled day and helped raise money for such an important and worthwhile charity.**
