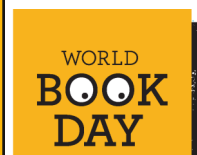

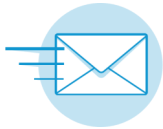
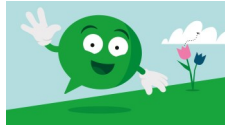

Thank you again to everyone who took part and raised money for this very worthwhile cause.

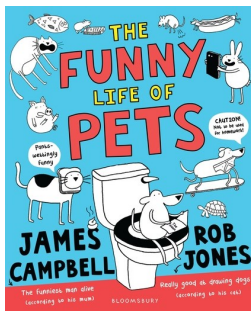


Please be aware we are now sending all school updates and information via school comms. If you are not receiving the fortnightly newsletter, please contact Mrs Stokes at Reception.
