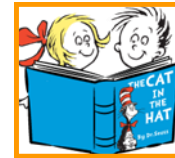

Due to the bad weather last week, we will now be celebrating World Book Day on Friday 16th March. Please come to school dressed up as a character from your favourite book.

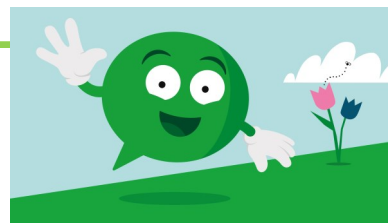
