An Oxford House School Book Bag is required in the Nursery and Lower school. From Form III satchels or plain black back packs should be used. No adornments permitted e.g. key rings or teddies.

Swimming and Sports kit should be brought in small bags on the appropriate day.

Long hair should be tied back- Hairbands should be pink, black or white with no adornments.
