

# Oxford House School Uniform List for Girls

Every item of clothing including shoes, socks and underwear must be clearly named.

Either Summer or Winter uniform may be worn until the October half-term

## Autumn & Spring Terms

School blazer

School beret

School tie

School long sleeved white blouse

School grey pinafore (NI – Form II only)

School grey kilt (Forms III – VI)

School sweater

Grey knee socks or thick woollen grey tights

Black school shoes (no boots, fashion shoes, patent shoes or ballerina pumps are permitted)

Black indoor plimsolls

Long sleeved plastic craft overall (fastening at the back)

## Winter

School duffle overcoat. No other coats are permitted

Plain black or grey gloves

## Summer Term

### **All Years except Form VI**

School dress

Plain white ankle socks, no frills or lace

White sun hat (not baseball cap)

### **Forms Nursery I to Form II**

May wear plain white cardigans

### **Form VI:**

School plain white regulation short sleeved blouse with reverse collar

School grey kilt

## PE/Games Uniform for FI - FVI

SUMMER UNIFORM (including Sports Day)

Summer PE uniform is worn until the October half-term and after Easter

White Ankle Socks

WINTER UNIFORM

Maroon Rugby shirt

Plain Navy Jersey Jogging Bottoms

Dark football boots - blades or moulded studs (FIII-FVI)

Boot bag (FIII-FVI)

White / Dark trainers

Shin Pads

Children will need a named water bottle. We recommend the use of a mouth guard. Shin pads may be worn.

### **Dancing & Dance Club**

#### **Forms I – IV**

School pink leotard  
Pink ballet shoes with elastic (no ribbons)  
White or pink ballet socks  
Pink hairband  
Pink ballet cross-over cardigan  
**Form III upwards** - Black Tap Shoes

#### **Forms V & VI only**

Black leotard with ruched front and separate lycra skirt  
Matching black hairband  
Pink ballet shoes with elastic (no ribbons)  
Pink ballet tights  
Black ballet cross-over cardigan

#### **Nursery & Reception only** – just the pink ballet shoes with elastic (no ribbons)

Unless attending Dance Club then as per Forms I – IV  
Plain navy blue jersey tracksuit trousers (as per games uniform) optional.

Parents are respectfully asked to note that school uniform is compulsory and must be strictly adhered to.

All pupils must keep a large shoe bag, clearly named at school.

Pupils in both our nurseries should keep a spare pair of underpants and socks in their shoe bag at school.

An Oxford House School Book Bag is required in the Nursery and Lower school.  
From Form III satchels or plain black back packs should be used.  
No adornments permitted e.g. key rings or teddies.

Swimming and Sports kit should be brought in small bags on the appropriate day.

Long hair should be tied back- Hairbands should be pink, black or white with no adornments.

**We recommend the use of a mouth guard for certain sports therefore suggest one is kept with your child's games kit.**
