**Extra** info

In Illyria they have a few custom rules that you might need to know about, when you enter Illyria you are allowed to carry some spirits and Gigars with you but it is limited to how much see below for the list:

- 200 cigarettes.
- 50 cigars.
- 1L of spirits.
- 2 L of wine.
- 2 L of Liquor but it must be duty free.
- If you are coming by boat and you are planning on staying, then you must take it back when you leave, and your boat must not have any tax on it.
